Youth Worker appointment

The South Cheltenham team has for the last four years had a contract with Youth for Christ to provide a youth work ministry. This has been led by Hanna Stürcken. A review of youth work provision has taken place across the team and it has been decided not to renew the contract with Youth for Christ but to employ a youth worker who will provide discipleship opportunities for young people within our churches and build new relationships beyond church including with the new Leckhampton school. The team is grateful to Hanna for all her work and wishes her well as she continues with Youth for Christ in another post.

The new post has been advertised and it is anticipated the person appointed will start work later in the Autumn. Associate Priest appointment

The Diocesan Mission and Pastoral group has approved the appointment of an Associate Priest in the South Cheltenham team. The post will be a House for Duty for Sundays and 2 days per week. The person appointed will be a pioneer priest who will establish a new worshipping community in Warden Hill working with families and who will also support the South Cheltenham team. It is expected the person appointed will be in post by the end of the year.
